Selection Policy.

Qualifying Period is January 1st 2026 to April 18th 2027.

Achieving a consideration performance does not guarantee selection as there are significant financial and logistical challenges associated with the 2027 Island Games. The size of the travelling party will be considerably smaller than in past Games. There are no “B” Standards, and it will not be part of the IOMAA policy to send younger, more inexperienced athletes who have not attained the consideration performance, to the Faroes.

Selection Panel:

This will be made up of:

- IOM Athletics Chairperson
- Island Games Team Manager
- Island Games Assistant Team Managers
- Head of Performance (Currently also an assistant team manager)
- 3 further representatives chosen from the clubs

A statistician will be appointed to provide data to all the selectors prior to the selection meetings but will not have a vote.

The selection panel is to be chosen by the IOMAA AGM in November 2026 and will meet periodically through 2027.

The selection meeting will be held on Monday April 19th 2027 and a further meeting on Wednesday 21st will be held to confirm the team.

Appeal Process:

Appeals will be allowed if the appellant puts in writing by close of business on April 24th 2027 to the IOMAA Secretary outlining the grounds of an appeal. The Appeal Panel will consist of:

- An independent Mediator / Facilitator
- Appellant
- The Selection Panel Chairperson or representative of the Panel
- Three neutral observers who will decide on the outcome. These will be people with experience in athletics, who have respect and standing but with no conflict of interest. Ideally former Island Games athletes could fill these roles.

The Appeal Panel will be constituted by the IOMAA AGM in November 2026. The Appeal Panel will meet as soon as is feasible but no later than Monday April 26th 2027.
